HOME BREWER - REGISTRATION

Welcome to the First Annual BrewHaha, Brewers Festival to benefit Developmental & Disability Services of Lebanon Valley (DDS).

The event is scheduled for Saturday, September 28, 2019 at the Tulpehocken Manor in Myerstown, PA and will be held from 5 – 9 p.m.

- A VIP Reception will be held from 5 – 6 p.m. with limited attendance of 100 guests. Chef Joe Edwards of the Porch Pub & Restaurant will provide a pub fare while guests have the opportunity to visit brew stands prior to general admission.
- General Admission is from 6-9 p.m. Guests are invited to enjoy samples of the various brews offered throughout the evening, while enjoying live entertainment by the Mendez Brothers. Various vendors will be on-site to provide food. (Food not included with ticket price.)

A key component of BrewHaha is a Home Brewers Competition.

Participating brewers will transport their brew(s) to the event, serve samples of their home brew(s) to event attendees, and remove their brew(s) and equipment when the event is over. We will hold a **People's Choice competition** for Home Brewers only. Guests will receive a ticket at admission to cast their vote for the brew that they like the most. At 8:30 p.m., votes will be collected and counted. The Brewer with the most votes will win a Gift Certificate to Lancaster Homebrew. All votes must be placed by 8:30 p.m. Competition winners will be announced at the end of the event (9:00PM).

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR BREWER PARTICIPATION:

Home brewers should bring one 5 gallon home group keg or two cases of bottled beer for every beer that they wish to serve at the event. Commercial Brewers should bring 2 sixtels.

Brewers and volunteers should have their stand set and ready to pour by 4:30 p.m.

Brewers must provide for all storage and pouring needs their brew(s) at the event.

Please label and monitor all personal property brought to the event. BrewHaha, the event venue, nor any volunteers recruited by BrewHaha are liable for any property damaged or stolen in association with this event.

Brewers, or their volunteers, must remain at their stations until all their brew(s) is/are gone, or until the awards presentation, whereby they are then responsible for cleaning their station and removing their materials.

Brewers and their volunteers must act in a professional and courteous manner to all event attendees.

Brewers will be supplied a tip jar that will be collected at 8:30 pm at the end of the competition. Tips will decide the People's Choice Winner, and all collected tips will be donated to Developmental & Disability Services of Lebanon Valley (DDS).

BrewHaha event staff are planning to put home brewers together in one large tent.

A simple sign will be provided with the Brewer's name/names, but if you have your own signage or banners please bring those to decorate your booth. Any and all decorations are welcome.

BrewHaha will have volunteers available to assist as needed.
