About Summer Stars

- The camp is administered by Developmental & Disability Services of Lebanon Valley.
- A Camp Coordinator and Camp Assistant oversee the day camp program.
- Planned activities are centered on a theme and designed to develop communication and social skills, along with team building techniques.
- DDS contracts a nurse to assist with activities of daily living, administering medications and to assist as needed.
- While DDS will strive to accommodate the special needs of campers, there may be some requests that we are unable to fulfill. For concerns, call DDS.
- DDS cannot guarantee 1:1 supervision of campers; if a child has a TSS it is strongly encouraged that the support person attend with the camper to ensure that all campers have an enjoyable experience.
- DDS uses a "Buddy" system. Campers partner with a high school student or adult volunteer. Buddies engage campers in activities and create an inclusive environment for campers.
- Limited scholarship funds are available. Priority given to Lebanon County residents.
