ABOUT THE LEGO CLUB

-  Members will meet at the DDS-Alley Learning Center for 1 1/2 hours to build their creations based on a theme for the evening.
-  DDS will provide the Legos and lead the group
-  The club will run on a rotating four-week schedule. Each session is independent of another so members can rotate in and out sessions to suit their personal schedule.
-  Enrollment for each session is limited to 10 members
-  The cost to participate for a four-week session is \$30 per member. Payment is expected at the time of registration.
-  Youth 7 years and older of all abilities welcome. For the benefit of all members, participants should be able to operate with minimal supervision.
-  The club will meet Tuesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

EVENING SCHEDULE:

6:00-6:15 P.M.: WELCOME TIME

The evening theme is announced. Members select a base-plate and Lego supplies

6:15-7:15 P.M.: FREE BUILDING TIME

Members build their creations accepting guidance from the Club Leader as needed. Toward the end of the free building time, members will be encouraged to write the names of their creations on a note card, along with their name. Each creation will be put on display along with the note card.

7:15-7:25 P.M.: SHARING TIME

Members tour the evening's creations with each member given the opportunity to talk about their creation.

7:25-7:30 P.M. CLOSING TIME

Members clean the building area
