About Summer Stars

- Developmental & Disability Services of Lebanon Valley administers four weeks of camp over the summer months
- Camps are led by a Camp Coordinator and Camp Assistant. Additional Staff may be hired to provide further supervision and assistance.
- A contract nurse will assist campers with activities of daily living, administering medications and perform duties as needed.
- While DDS will strive to accommodate the special needs of campers, there may be some requests that we are unable to fulfill. For concerns, call DDS.
- DDS cannot guarantee 1:1 supervision of campers; if a child has a TSS it is strongly encouraged that the support person attend the program with the camper. This is the best practice to ensure that all campers have an enjoyable camp experience.
- DDS uses a "Buddy" system. Campers partner with a high school student or adult volunteer. Buddies engage campers in activities and create an inclusive environment for campers.
- The camp is a recreational camp program and is not licensed as a therapeutic camp

Is Summer Stars for You

- Camp is for children of all abilities age 8 - 17
- Camp runs from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Four days each week
- DDS will frequently divide campers into age/intellectually appropriate groups to ensure that campers are engaged in camp activities
- DDS takes precautions to address various needs campers may have, including assistance with activities of daily living, dietary needs, medicine(s), and communication aides.
- Cost of the Camp is \$185 per week and includes:
 - T-shirt
 - Activities
 - Snacks
 - Transportation and admission fees for field trips
 - Campers are asked to bring a packed lunch
- Scholarship funds are available and are distributed on an as needed basis. Priority given to Lebanon County residents.
